The regime has gone beyond military objectives, leveling entire neighborhoods and destroying homes in an attempt to devastate areas it cannot control. ‘Scorched earth’ is a military policy involving deliberate and usually widespread destruction of property and resources (as housing and factories) so that an invading enemy cannot use them.
